A popular family attraction, the BREC Baton Rouge Zoo was long overdue for significant enhancements. Consisting of general site improvements, renovations and additions to existing buildings, the project included construction of new buildings for various amenities including the Train Pavilion, Flamingo Café and South American Exhibit. The entry plaza consists of stamped colored concrete which replicates a natural dirt appearance and features a stone sphere fountain rotating with the axis of the earth. In addition, structures called for special exterior applications in order to transform areas according to theme. With public safety constraints and critical coordination of deliveries and concrete pours part of the overall logistics strategy, D. Honoré Construction was able to successfully complete the project on time and to everyone's satisfaction.
