PROJECT NOTES

When the opportunity to work for a highly respected and popular school on the LSU campus became a reality, DHC responded enthusiastically. Destroyed by a fire in the spring of 2007, the gathering site for cherished all-school celebrations, lively pep rallies and school dances, the gym suffered significant damage. Fire consumed the ceiling and roofing, scoreboards, bleachers, lighting and sound. In addition, a number of windows were blown out by the intense heat and standing water had damaged the basketball court beyond repair.

Unusable for an entire season, an expedient renovation was critical. True to form, DHC was able to complete the project in spite of unforeseen conditions, donating and installing a custom floor that included a logo of the school mascot and a banner system recognizing the school's patrons and supporters.
